

History of the MAX CHALLENGE GRAND FINALS From Puerto Rico to Portugal and from 66 to 195 drivers

In 1999 BRP-ROTAX introduced a karting series around the world the so-called 'ROTAX MAX Challenge' (RMC). It started not to say it launched and we all know where is it today.



The absolute highlight of the annual race season on national as well as international level is of course the grand final, where drivers from different nations, different continents gather to crown the best amongst them.

It all began as a "playfield" for ambitious leisure kart drivers and today we are running one of the most prestigious events in the world of professional karting.

Let us go back in history

The first final was held in the year 2000 on the wonderful island of Puerto Rico, organizing such a event without big experience was a real challenge and needed people with great creativity and courage.



It all began with 66 drivers from 19 different nations.

Together with the MAX challenge program also the finals grew every year.

2001 the grand finals were invited to the tropical island of Langkawi in Malaysia, the support of the Malaysians from local supporters up to the government was

great and made it an unforgettable event.

We were able to invite even more drivers this time, finally 68 drivers from 29 countries were trying to become the Max challenge "world champion"

South Africa hosted the grand finals in 2002 on the track just outside Pretoria drivers from 33 different nations were focused to go for gold. The top podium spot at the first 3 grand finals was in south African hands only, no way to beat them so far.

2003 the finals moved to Egypt, it was the year of a major change in the schedule of the grand finals, the junior category was introduced as well as the first time ROTAX cooperated with a chassis manufacturer to supply similar karts to competitor. The junior category raced on a single make chassis supplied by CRG while the seniors still raced on their private chassis.

This move increased the number of participants to almost 100 from close to 40 different nations.

2004 the 5th grand finals were held on the volcano island of Lanzerote in Spain, another change to the program was introduced. First time all the competitors raced on supplied single make chassis supplied again by CRG for the junior and by BRP-ROTAX for the senior category, the senior category used first




time the RM1 chassis with the new 2-speed shifter engine – the 125 MAX DD2. The number of participants remained unchanged at close to 100.




THE TRACK

Kartódromo de Viana is an international circuit, located on the northern part of Portugal, 4 Km from the city of Viana do Castelo, 1 km far from very nice beaches, 60 km far from Porto and 80 Km far from Vigo (Spain).



Kartódromo de Viana, inaugurated in 2000, has an area of 100.000 m2. It is the only complex in Portugal with 2 tracks - one for rental with 468 m2 and the other one with international C grade homologation, with 1117m long - and has very good facilities: bar, restaurant, showers, offices and conference rooms, padock with 6.000 m2, garages for parking the karts, racing workshop, slots track, shops and 120 rental karts, includind for kids.








Finally in 2005 we went back to Malaysia, the finals there featured another move forward. This time BRP-ROTAX managed to grow the event by running it with 3 categories (junior MAX, senior MAX and the RM1 shifter category). First time BRP-ROTAX and it's local partners handled close to 140 drivers from 43 different nations. Also a new supporter joined the family. Swiss Hutless from Switzerland stepped forward and supported the finals by supplying 55 race-ready chassis for the junior category, while the seniors used CRG chassis. Beside these changes BRP-ROTAX introduced the newly designed MOJO tires on this international platform.

Now we are looking forward to a great event in Viana do Castelo in Portugal, an approximate number of 195 drivers from close to 50 different nations will go for the victory in junior MAX, senior MAX and DD2 category.

We wish all the competitors great success and all of us the event of our lifes!

Keep the "olympic spirit" in mind and may the best drivers win!




Turned Towards the Future
