MOJO TIRE CHANGING CONTEST

After La Conca in 2008, the MOJO tire changing contest has proved to be a very popular and entertaining side event.

The task is for mechanics, representing their home country, to manually remove a full set of tires of their rims, then re-mount all four in the fastest time possible.

Last year America's Wes Boswell threw down a smoking fast time that left everybody stunning. We'll see if someone is able to break his record of 31,96 sec at this year's Grand Finals 2009.

CIRCUIT DETAILS

The circuit itself (length: 1,308 mt) has been built to the standards set by the "Commission Internationale de Karting" (CIK-FIA) and the authorized international body within the "Federation Internationale d'Automobile" (FIA). Today, Ghibli Raceway's Sharm facility is proudly one of only four homologated tracks in the world with a "Grade A license". Our fervor for the sport and its development has spurred us to continuously develop our service to be unsurpassed in all aspects. A testament to Ghibli's success was hosting the prestigious Rotax Max Challenge World Finals, the most international (38 countries) and popular (+7,000 competitors) FIA sanctioned motor sport formula in January, 2004.

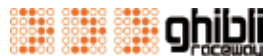
